Acting in association with a Nigerian joint venture Alpro, the firm was commissioned to undertake a study and prepare a Master Plan for the collection, treatment and disposal of liquid wastes and surface water in the City of Abeokuta. The study also involved a detailed evaluation of water supply proposals for the City.

The study covered not only the existing population of some 300,000 but also had taken into account of anticipated development of the City, the State Capital, for a period of 25 years.

An essential part of the study was the investigation of the centre core of the town where development had taken place without adequate access and where the majority of the people had limited water supply and no alternative sanitation to open ground defecation.

The study was also concerned with proposals for alleviating flooding which occurred in the wet season due to the dense development that had taken place in the watersheds of the various streams flowing through the City.

The study involved the review of all existing proposals for the development of water sanitation and drainage infrastructure within the City. In particular, it involved socio-economic surveys and confirmation and verification of census information through area sampling of population. All proposals were developed on the basis of technical suitability and financial affordability. Institutional arrangements were thoroughly reviewed and proposals made for their strengthening.
